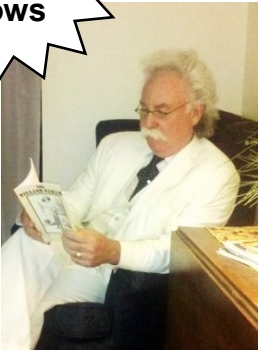

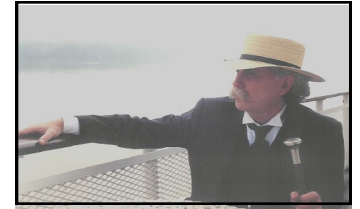

Richard Garey is an acclaimed actor and playwright best known for his original stage play MARK TWAIN HIMSELF. He has delighted audiences throughout the United States, Canada and Bermuda for over 30 years. Richard was born in Jackson, Tennessee and now calls Hannibal, Missouri, home.

Since 2004 Richard has performed MARK TWAIN HIMSELF in the Planters Barn Theater in Hannibal's Historic District, Samuel Clemens boyhood home. Richard also performs regularly on riverboats and in theaters throughout the country.

The original stage play MARK TWAIN HIMSELF re-creates Mark Twain's famous 'lectures', part readings from his books and part stand up comedy. Richard proudly delivers only Twain's material. He has over seven hours of original Twain writing and letters in his repertoire and interacts freely with the audience during the performances maintaining a fresh, impromptu approach. No two shows are exactly alike – all shows are 100% Twain.

In a theater career that spans four decades, Richard Garey has performed in everything from Shakespeare to musicals, taught theater and literature, appeared in television commercials, and directed numerous plays and musicals over the years.

Because of Richard's scholarship and familiarity with Samuel Clemens' life and writings he has developed Twain shows featuring specific topics such as Life on the Mississippi, Slave Stories, Roughing It, The Women in My Life, How to Tell a Story, and Mark Twain for President.

Richard has a Masters in English from James Madison University in Virginia, is a published poet, and has written and performed other one man shows most notably A SHEPHERD'S TALE, CENTURIAN, and ON THE SEVENTH DAY OF CHRISTMAS.
